

Car parking for Leicester City Campus

Please note there is no visitor car park on De Montfort University's City Campus. The nearest public car parks are listed below, and shown on the map opposite.

A. Newarke Street (Phoenix)

Multi-storey, operated by City Council
Approx five min walk from Campus
Open Mon–Sat 6.30am–1am; Friday 6.30am–1.30am
Open some Sundays
Charges (pay on foot): from £1.40–£7.30
24 hours – varies with time of arrival.
Blue badge holders free of charge.
Free cycle racks.

B. St Nicholas Circle

Multi-storey, operated by NCP Ltd
Approx ten min walk from Campus
Open 24 hours
Charges: from £3.10 for two hours

C. Welford Road

Multi-storey, operated by NCP Ltd
Approx seven min walk from Campus
Open 24 hours
Charges: from £3.10 for two hours

D. Highcross

Multi-storey, operated by Highcross Shopping Centre
Approx 15 min walk from Campus
Charges: from £2.20 + £1.00 per hour thereafter

E. Almond Road

Surface level, operated by Euro Car Parks
Approx 15 min walk from Campus
Open 24 hours
Charges: from £0.50–£4.50
Sundays: free parking

F. Granby Halls

Surface level, operated by NCP Ltd
Approx 15 min walk from Campus
Open 24 hours
Charges (pay and display): from £1–£10.

Park and ride

Quicksilver shuttle route between Meynells Gorse (off Hinckley Road, Leicester Forest East) and the Clock Tower. £1.60 single, £2.50 return and runs from 7am until 7pm, every 15 minutes.

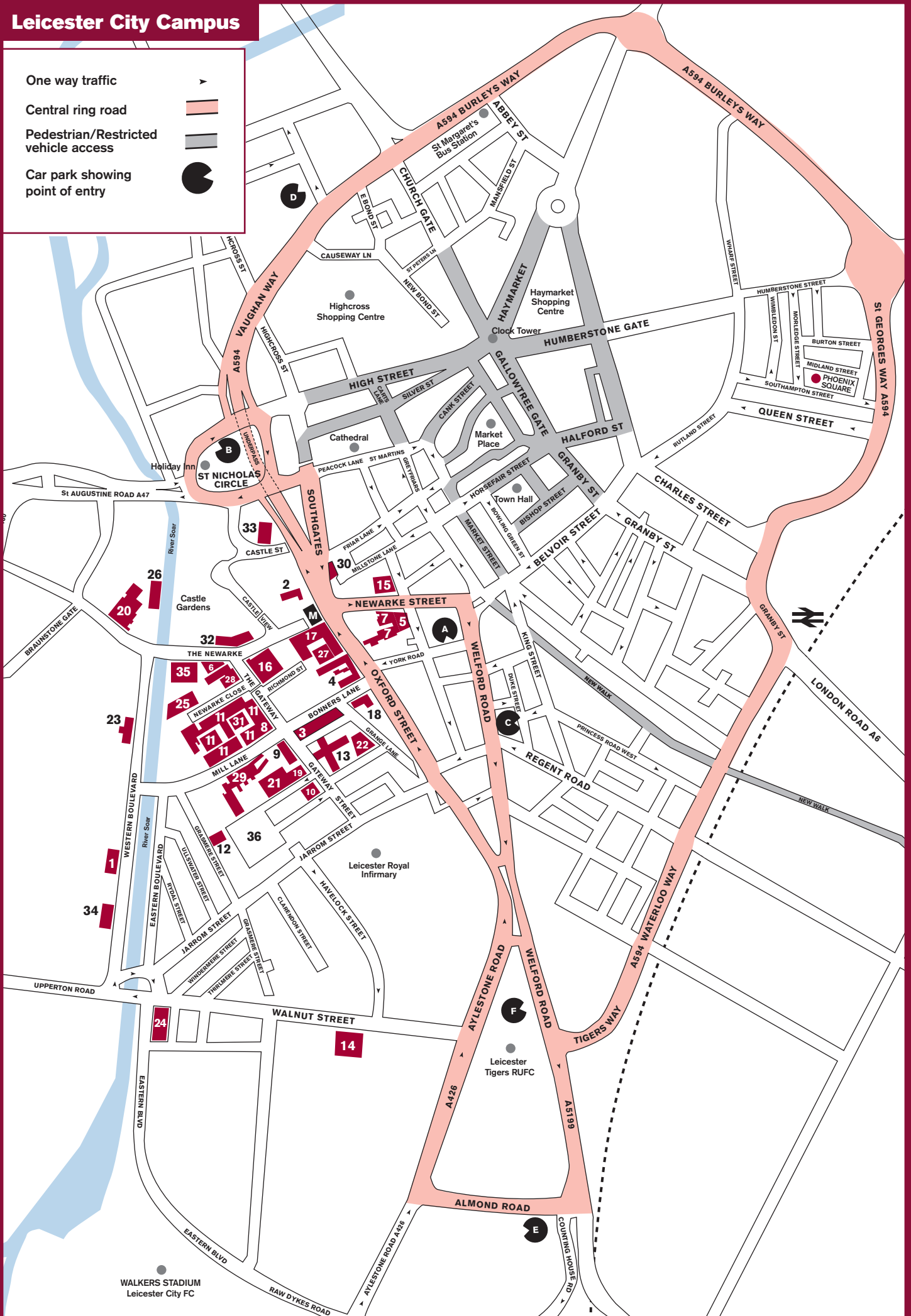

One way traffic

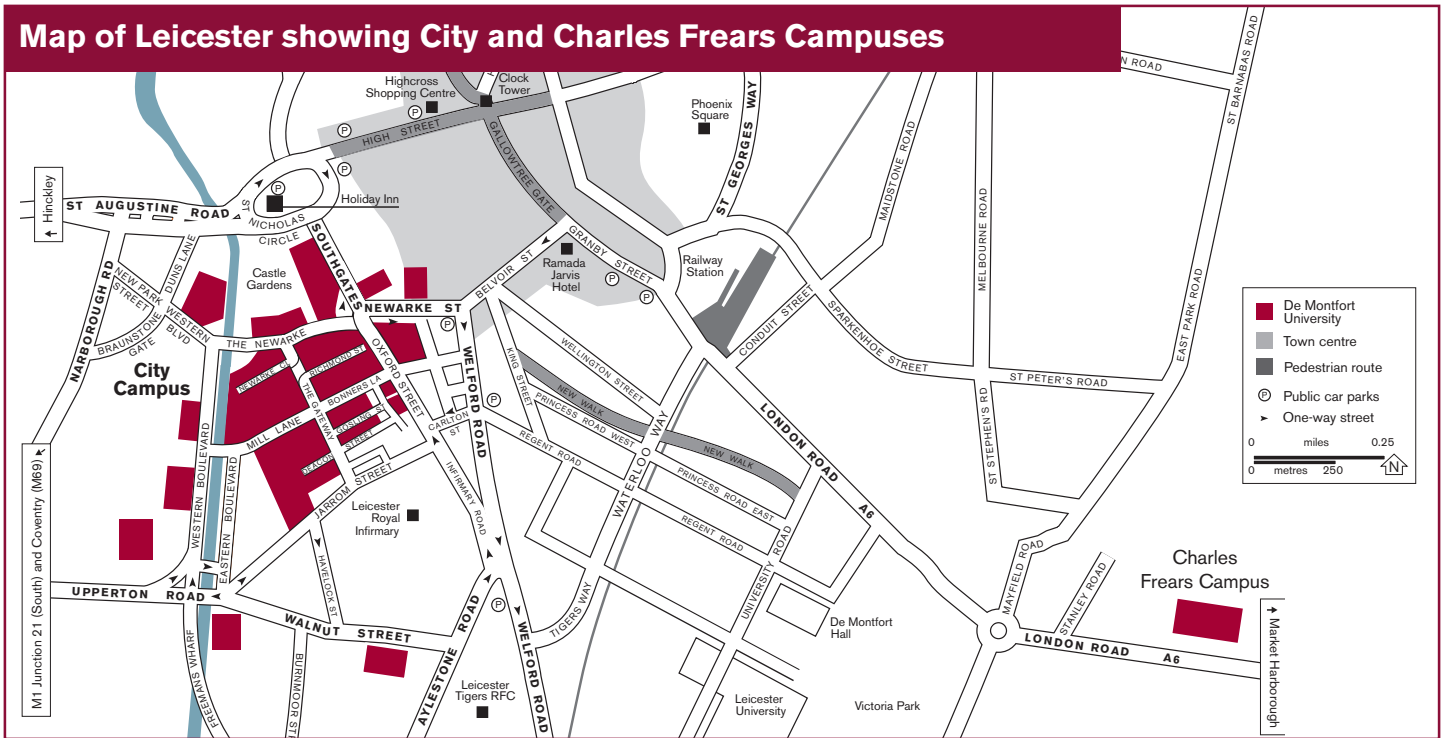
Central ring road

Pedestrian/Restricted vehicle access

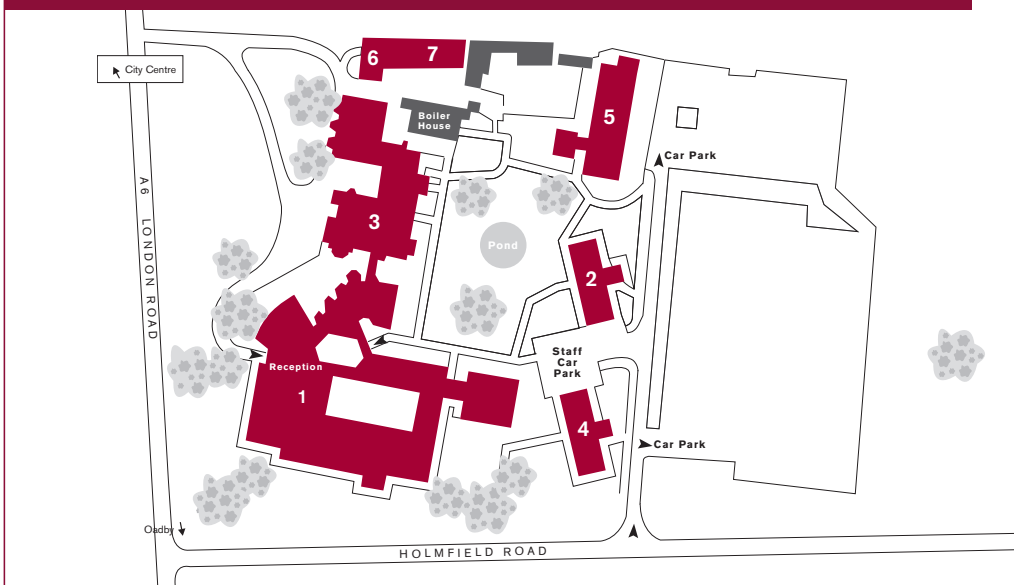
Car park showing point of entry

To Charles Frears Campus

Charles Frears Campus is slightly out of the city centre, but still close to the train station. It is a 20 minute walk from the station.

If arriving by car, follow directions as for the City Campus, but once near the city centre head for the A6 south (London Road) towards Market Harborough.

The Campus is on London Road (A6), just south of Victoria Park Road and about a mile from the city centre. Access is via Holmfield Road (left off London Road). Car parking is available for visitors.
